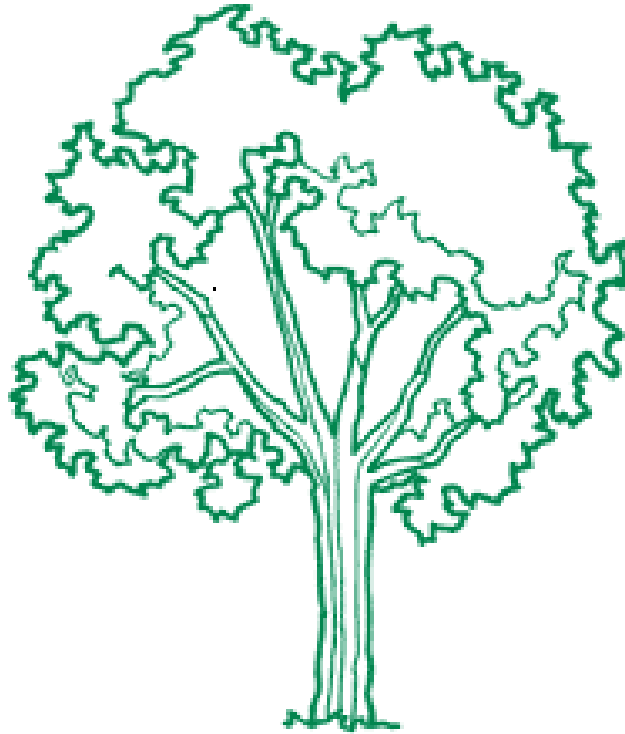

Personal Appearance

Uniform

Students are ambassadors of the school and, as such are expected to dress and behave in a way that reflects our high standards. The uniform should be smart with all items clearly marked by name. If students are unable to wear the uniform for any reason, the school must be notified directly by the parents. Deviation will be allowed for medical reasons following discussion with the Headteacher.

School Uniform

Charcoal grey pinafore, skirt, trousers or shorts
Light blue gingham summer dress
Grey/white socks (with skirts), plain dark socks (with shorts/trousers)
White polo shirt (no blouses or shirts)
Charcoal Grey Tights
Royal Blue Cardigan or Sweatshirt
Black Shoes (no boots, trainers or sandals)

PE Uniform (Inside)

Royal Blue shorts
Sky Blue polo shirt
Black Pumps

Outdoor PE

Light Grey Hoodie (Optional)
Trainers
Ear rings to be removed for PE

Important Points/Recent Amendments

- No black clothing – all darker clothing to be charcoal grey
- A light grey hooded sweatshirt is available for outdoor PE
- No shirts or blouses, just white polo shirts
- Please ensure all skirts are a respectable length

Make-up and Piercing

For Health and Safety reasons no jewellery other than one plain stud in the lobe of each ear is allowed. No make-up or nail-varnish are allowed. No wrist bands, other than charity or official team colour wrist bands promoted by school are allowed. Ear rings should be removed on PE days prior to attending school.

Hair

Students must ensure that hair is of one natural colour at all times. Hair should have no bright or extreme colourings. Hair should be off the face or tied back at all times. No shavings, etchings or extreme styling will be tolerated and hair should be no shorter than a Grade 2. Hair pieces such as bows and ribbons should be minimalistic and not excessive.
